Biodynamic research is done in all agricultural fields in many places of the world. It makes use of a great diversity of methods and disciplines, getting in touch with many other research areas such as agroecology. Taking an inter- and transdisciplinary approach, we aim to bring together both academic research and farmer's expertise to explore and discuss burning issues in biodynamic food and farming systems. We want to look at these issues both from a classical scientific and an innovative methodological perspective.

During the 3-day conference, the parallel sessions and workshops offer the opportunity to listen to and discuss various contributions from scientists and researching farmers from around the world on following topics:

- New scientific methods in academic and on-farm research
- The farm organism and (new) perspectives in agroecology
- Beyond matter: Non-material influences on agriculture quantum physics & co in agriculture
- Associative economy an approach to sustainable food systems
- Living soil, soil life, and soil fertility
- Research on plants
- Food for live food quality, nutrition and health
- Animal welfare

We also offer "experience the living" - exercises to learn about soil, plants, animals and some biodynamic practices such as the preparations. In a post-conference excursion we are going to visit a biodynamic farm.

A World Café session, coffee breaks and the conference dinner will give you many opportunities to meet colleagues and connect with them. In addition, we will invite you to work on a strategic agenda by exploring which questions are the most urgent and how we can make future research happen in a collaborative way.

The conference is aimed at researchers, farmer researchers, students and anyone interested in biodynamic research.
